

Crawford County Seeks Comments on Applying New Pavement Markings to Various County Roads

Bucyrus – The Crawford County Engineer’s Office is proposing to improve the existing longitudinal pavement markings by applying new polyester pavement markings to various County-maintained roadways.

The following roads will receive new polyester pavement markings for all or part of their length:

Construction is anticipated to begin no sooner than May of 2025 and will be completed by the end of August 2025. There will be no detours and this project is considered a moving operation with cone placements to prevent tracking of wet paint. No right-of-way is required for this project.
